



## The Candlelight Club is run to assist in the raising of funds for Across

The Candlelight Club is simplicity in itself to join and every participant gets the chance to win in the monthly and annual draws. Members of the Candlelight must be over 16 years old to join and pay by standing order (Cheques are accepted for annual payment).

You will then be allocated your numbers and included in the monthly draws.

The numbers are £4 per month (£48 per year)

The Charity will pay out depending upon the number of entrants, as shown in the table below:

*Please note that monthly subscriptions must be received before the draw otherwise your numbers won't be included – subscriptions are due on the 1<sup>st</sup> of the month and the draw will take place around the 20<sup>th</sup> of the month.*

## Across Candlelight Club Rules

- 1: The name of the draw is The Candle Light Club ("the Lottery") regardless of the number of shares.
- 2: The purpose of the Lottery is to raise funds for the sole benefit of Across ("the Charity").
- 3: The Lottery will be administered by a Promoter appointed by the Trustees of the Charity.
- 4: The Lottery will be open to anybody aged 16 or over. A purchaser of a share becomes a participant in the lottery. Participants are entitled to hold any number of shares.
- 5: The subscription for each share is £4 per month payable monthly in advance by standing order. Participants may also pay annually **in advance** by Standing Order or cheque (made payable to Across).
6. Numbers will be allocated in sequence when applications are received. No preference for a particular number will be granted.
7. To be entered into the annual draw, all participants must have made 6 months' contributions. Any new member who has been a member for a shorter time may take part but will need to pay £4 per month for the number of months by which contributions are short.
- 8: There shall be a draw made each month using the automatic random number generator on [www.random.org](http://www.random.org) or by other such means as the Promoter deems appropriate. The draw will be taken in the presence of the General Manager or their representative. Monthly prize winning numbers will be drawn in the following order: 1st prize, 2nd prize and 3rd prize, where applicable, followed by the Annual Draw, which will be drawn in the same order, when due.
9. The monthly draw will be taken on or around the 20<sup>th</sup> of the month. The annual draw will be taken at the same time as the Monthly draw in December
- 10: Winners will be paid by cheque, which will be sent to the last known address held by the promoter. No number can win two of the monthly or annual prizes. However potentially, a number could win a monthly as well as an annual prize, when those draws coincide on the same date. It is the responsibility of the participant to advise the Promoter of any change of address. Any prize cheque not cashed within 6 months will be deemed a donation to the Charity. A list of prize winning numbers will be published in the next Charity Newsletter
- 11: The Promoter will not pay a prize to any Participant other than the purchaser of a winning share.
- 12: No Lottery participant will be included in the draw if the subscription has not been received. It is the responsibility of each Participant to make sure they have paid their subscription. The Promoter reserves the right to reallocate any number where payment has not been received.
- 13: Participants can cancel their entry in the Lottery at any time by giving one month's written notice to the Promoter. Any decision by the Charity to end the lottery will also be by one month's notice to all Participants.
- 14: Under no circumstances can subscriptions be refunded.
- 15: The Promoter will determine any dispute. An appeal may be made to the Charities Trustees whose decision shall be final.
- 16: The Lottery is intended to be a Small Society Lottery under the provisions of the Gambling Act 2005 Section 19.
- 17: The Charity may amend or vary the rules of the lottery at any time. The rules of the Lottery will be available from the Charity at any time. Changes will be notified to Participants via the Charity newsletter.
